

What you need to know for registration in each class and specialised class of plumbing work

To be eligible to be registered in a class or specialised class of plumbing work:

- you must have the qualifications (a relevant Certificate III or Certificate II course in plumbing) and experience set out in the Plumbing Regulations 2008

OR

- you must satisfy the VBA that you have knowledge and competence equal to a person who has those qualifications and experience.

If you don't have the qualification and experience set out in the Regulations, the VBA will assess your knowledge and competence against the requirements of the relevant Certificate III or II course in plumbing, as set out in the following tables.
