## Victorian Building Authority boosts strategic capability

The Victorian Building Authority (VBA) has further strengthened its regulatory strategy capacity through the appointment of Mark Rossiter as Chief Corporate and Regulatory Strategy Officer.

Mr Rossiter joins the VBA after a career in the aviation industry, having most recently led a number of strategic functions at Airservices Australia, including service strategy, investment prioritisation, property and stakeholder engagement. Prior to this, Mr Rossiter's career has included roles in aircraft engineering in Ireland, Germany, Switzerland and ultimately with the Qantas Group.

Mr Rossiter was the Head of Aviation Safety and Compliance for Jetstar for a number of years and also held leadership roles with the Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA), most recently as Manager Safety Oversight in CASA's operational headquarters in Brisbane.

In announcing Mr Rossiter's appointment, VBA CEO Sue Eddy said his experience would be valuable to the Authority at a time when industry growth and the challenges it brings demands a strong focus on compliance and regulatory strategy.

"Mark has proven high-level experience in regulatory strategy, something that will further boost strategic capability at the VBA," said Ms Eddy.

Mr Rossiter commenced his role at the VBA on 27 November.
