Any record of inspection relied upon by you, as the RBS, to give the section 33(3) notification to the Authority
Any relevant photographs of the site or the building work the subject of the building permit
Any building notice or building order issued by you, as the RBS, in response to the section 33(1) and/or section 33(2) contravention by the builder named in the building permit
If applicable , any record of inspection or expert report or certificate of compliance evidencing compliance with a building notice issued by you, as the RBS
If applicable , any cancellation of building notice or cancellation of building order issued by you related to the section 33(1) and/or section 33(2) contravention by the builder named in the building permit
Any other information which you, as the RBS, consider may be relevant to this matter
Evidence of service of any building notices and/or builder orders in accordance with section 236 of the Act (please include any copies that was sent via email)

- Notifying the Victorian Building Authority of this matter may result in the Authority taking action which could include, as appropriate, a warning letter to the builder, disciplinary action and/or prosecution.
- You are reminded that you remain the relevant building surveyor for the building work, for which you were appointed and that it is your continuing responsibility to ensure appropriate enforcement action is undertaken to ensure compliance.
- o To assist the Victorian Building Authority in making a determination in this matter, the Authority may request further information from you.
