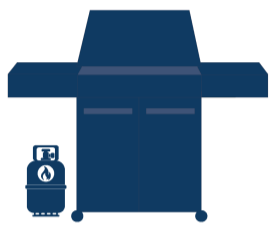


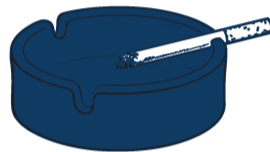
# IMPORTANT FIRE SAFETY TIPS

REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE BY REMOVING POTENTIAL IGNITION  
SOURCES FROM BALCONIES AND COMMON AREAS



## Barbecues

Ensure BBQs are 50cm from walls, clothing and other flammable material. Store gas bottles outside, upright and away from heat sources.



## Smoking

Ensure cigarettes are fully extinguished in a heavy, high-sided ashtray.



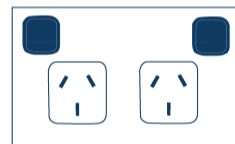
## Heaters

Avoid the use of patio heaters on balconies.



## Smoke alarms

Ensure smoke alarms are not covered or disconnected.



## Electrical wiring

Do not use any electrical items where the wiring runs through non-compliant combustible cladding.



## Air conditioning

Isolate air conditioning units and ensure flammable materials are kept at least 1 metre away.



## Housekeeping

Ensure leaves and other materials do not build up on the ground. Also ensure you keep bins clear of walls with combustible cladding.



## Fire extinguisher

Ensure a dry-powder fire extinguisher easily accessible. Use only if you feel able.



## Fire doors

Keep fire doors clear, closed and unblocked at all times. Make sure you know your building's evacuation plan.
